Condolences

As a school community we have received some very sad news in the last couple of weeks.

A fortnight ago we learned that ex-student Marnie Malone had passed away following illness. Staff will be attending her funeral at Our Lady and St George's Church next week. Our thoughts and prayers are with Marnie's family.

We also received the shocking news last weekend that one of our ex-students, Moyra Whelan, was killed in a car crash last Friday. Moyra is the sister of two current staff members, Mrs Gaynor and Mrs Wilbraham; she was also Head of History at Woodbridge High School.

Also injured in the crash was Nicola Thorogood, whose mother Mrs Thorogood is one of the receptionists at Holy Family. Nicola is currently receiving treatment in intensive care.

Please join us in praying for the repose of the souls of Marnie and Moyra, and for a full recovery for Nicola. Please keep their families and loved ones in your thoughts at this very sad time so close to Christmas.

Some students have already been invited and are attending extra sessions. It is extremely important that your child attends any sessions they have been allocated and you will receive notification of non-attendance from their teachers.

A small number of students who are experiencing barriers to their success have been identified by senior staff and we will be contacting the parents of those students to meet with us and look at how we can work with you and your child to ensure that they reach their potential in the summer examinations.

Year 13 mock examinations and UCAS entries

Year 13 students are currently sitting mock examinations for their A-level and vocational courses and will receive their results in the new term.

The Sixth Form team and students have been working together to ensure that all UCAS entries are ready and sent off in good time. UCAS is the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service and all students wishing to access Higher Education must apply to their chosen institutions by January. We are delighted that the highest number ever of our Year 13 students have been invited to interview at Oxford and Cambridge. The Sixth Form team and senior staff have helped them prepare by conducting "Moxbridge" interviews and we wish them the very best of luck!

Assessments

Students in Years 7,8,9, and 12 have also sat assessments in all curriculum subjects and reports will be shared with parents/carers shortly. We will be contacting the parents/carers of students causing concern after the Christmas break and will be looking at how we can work with you and your child to give them the best chance to succeed.
