<u>8 June 2025 - Pentecost Year C</u> John 14:15-16, 23b-26 'The Holy Spirit will teach you everything'

Pentecost is one of the most important feast days of the year and concludes the Easter season. Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room.
