Dear Parents/Carers,

We returned on Monday and launched straight back into public exams. I have been extremely impressed with the students' punctuality, attendance and behaviour during this period - all have been exemplary. As we said farewell to our Sixth Form students at the end of last half term, I reminded them that they are always part of the Holy Family family, and that we want them to stay in touch and let us know of all their future successes! As Year 11 come towards the end of the GCSE exams I extend the same to them, although the majority will be returning to our Sixth Form, HFSix, with record numbers applying.
