We also celebrated women in STEM careers as part of our International Women's Day events. We were extremely privileged to welcome Helen Sharman, the first British person in space, who came in to speak to our students. What an honour! We also heard from Florianne Fidegnon who spoke about careers for women in STEM. Floriane founded and led the Warwick Women's Engineering Society, is a Royal Academy of Engineering Leaders Scholar, and Chairperson of the Stemetite Futures Youth board. Freddie Pearce spoke to students on digital creative industries and our very own Mr Wynter spoke about careers in IT.

As well as these fantastic speakers, students also participated in workshops designed to get them thinking about their career aspirations and developing skills for the work place, such as interview techniques, how to email like a professional, and set themselves goals.
