Dear Parents/Carers and Year 13 student

Strike action trike action Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May – arrangements for Year 13 students only.

On Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May, <u>all Year 13 students are expected to</u> <u>attend school.</u> This is to ensure students continue to be supported for their final exams/coursework. Students must wear full dress code / pass as normal.

To ensure students can be supported appropriately, there will be a bespoke timetable for the days, based around the option blocks students chose for their A Level/BTECs. There will be two teaching sessions on each day (10am – 12midday and 12midday to 2pm.) Students will be expected to attend the sessions that correspond to their option block choices as below.

Students therefore do not need to attend school in a session where their option block is not being taught – they should instead study at home. For most students this means they will attend 3 of the 4 sessions across the two days.
