What does the qualification cover?



This course offers an engaging introduction to the real world of the Music industry. It incorporates a variety of different aspect from within the industry including Careers, Sequencing, Composing and promotion of a product. This interactive course offers you the practical application of knowledge through DAW such as Garageband on a suite of Mac computers.

The qualification is 120 GLH and level 1/level 2, which is the same size and level as a GCSE, and is aimed at everyone who wants to develop their understanding of different areas within the sports industry.

How will I be assessed?

Unit 1 is a written exam which is assessed by the exam board.

For the remainder of the units You will be presented with a brief which you and your class will work through with your teacher these are then assessed by your teacher and moderated by the exam board.
