GCSE Points scores

To access both the A Level pathway and the L3 BTEC Pathway, students are required to gain a GCSE average as outlined in the tables above.

Level 3 study is challenging and requires an existing base of knowledge as proven by GCSE results.

Students can 'model' their likely GCSE average by adding up all their current predicted grades (in number form) and dividing by the total number of GCSEs.
