

A Levels and Level 3 BTECs require a high level of prior knowledge and skills, as demonstrated through GCSE results. As a result, we advertise clear entry requirements for each course. Students who narrowly miss entry requirements will be considered on an individual basis.

### A Level Curriculum offer

Students studying A Levels usually study 3 A Levels, plus an additional subject such as EPQ and Core Maths, alongside compulsory General Religious Studies, Study sessions and Enrichment

### Level 3 BTEC Vocational Offer

Students studying Level 3 BTECS usually study the equivalent of 3 A Levels (usually combining two BTECs together), alongside compulsory General Religious Studies, Study sessions and Enrichment

### GCSE Points scores

To access both the A Level pathway and the L3 BTEC Pathway, students are required to gain a GCSE average as outlined in the tables above. Level 3 study is challenging and requires an existing base of knowledge as proven by GCSE results.

Students can 'model' their likely GCSE average by adding up all their current predicted grades (in number form) and dividing by the total number of GCSEs.

## **Level 2 Bridging course / BTEC Vocational Offer**

This is a one year course that can lead to Level 3 study next year, on successful completion of all aspects and meeting the minimum entry requirements for Level 3

Students choose one from:

- Level 2 BTEC Business
- Level 2 BTEC Health and Social care

Students who do not have a grade 4+ in English choose either:

- GCSE English resit
- Functions Skills English (best for students who gained a grade 1 or 2 in English GCSE)

Students who do not have a grade 4+ in Maths choose either:

- GCSE Maths resit
- Functions Skills Maths (best for students who gained a grade 1 or 2 in Maths GCSE)

Additional skills course eg: ASDAN certificate of personal effectiveness
