- He arranged the objects and later used them to create boxed pieces of sculpture.

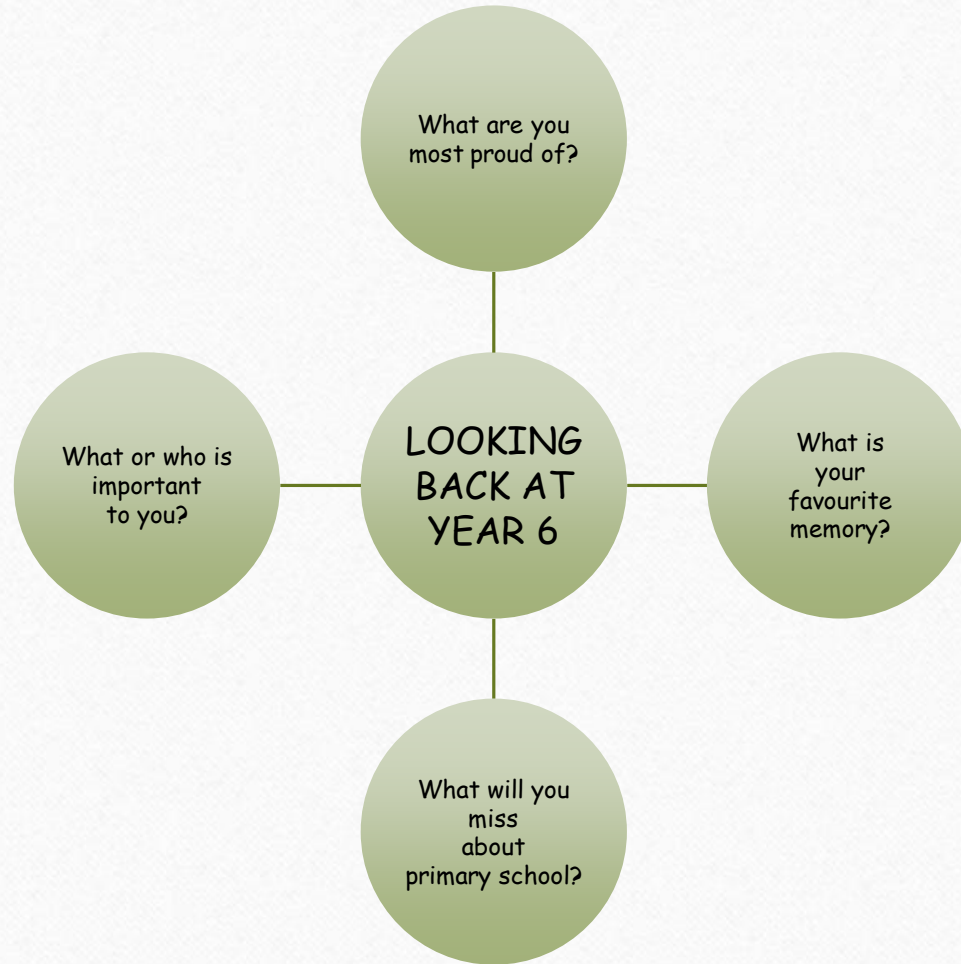

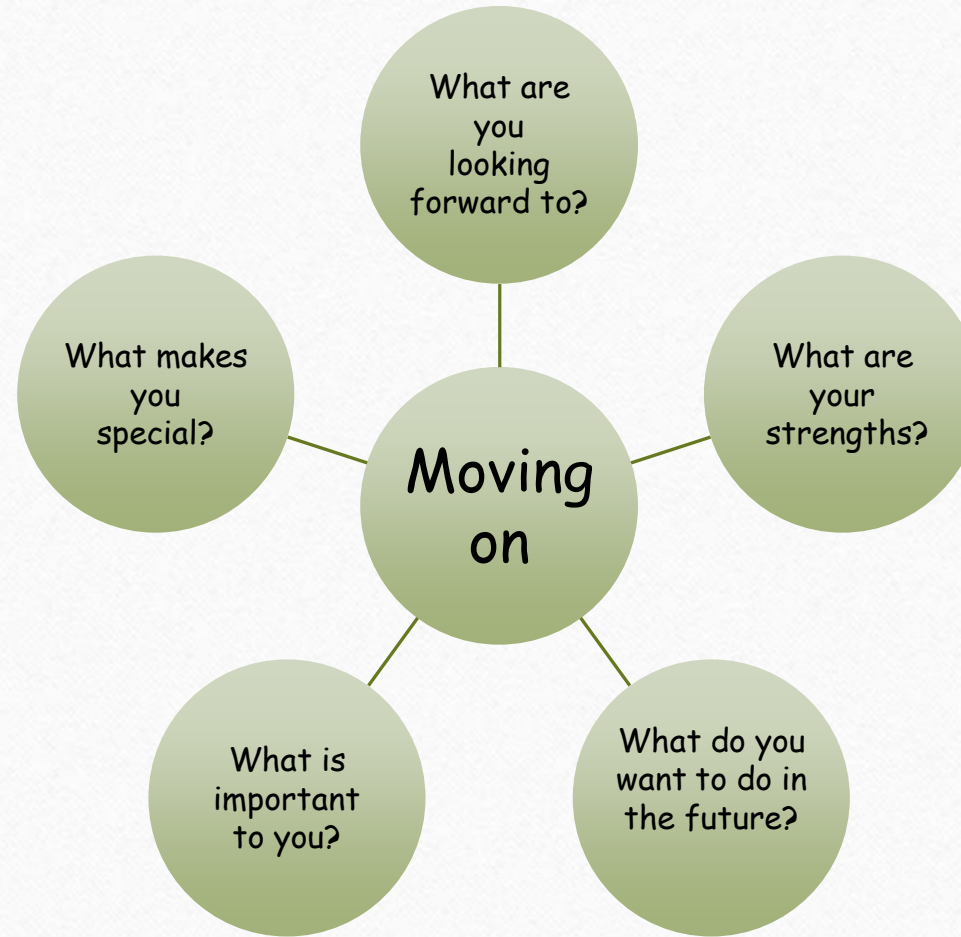
YOUR TASK
