HOLY FAMILY SIXTH FORM: DRESS CODE

You come to Sixth Form to work – your 'wages' are your grades at the end of the course – as you are coming to work we expect you to dress for work and abide by the following code; if not, sanctions will be issued and you may be sent home to change. Persistent offenders will be asked to leave the Sixth Form.

Males in the Sixth Form must wear:

- A dark formal suit, comprising matching jacket and trousers
- A business shirt with a formal collar (you may choose the colour of the shirt)
- A formal tie (you may choose the colour of the tie)
- A pair of smart, business-like leather shoes
- Black, navy blue or grey socks
- Security Pass on lanyard, visible always (provided at induction)
- Please note that jumpers may be worn under a suit jacket in colder months but do not replace a suit jacket.
- Hair should be natural colours only.
- Small stud earrings only are allowed. Large hoops, eyebrow, nose and other face studs and rings are **not** allowed.

Females must wear the following:

- A dark formal suit comprising a matching jacket and full length trousers. No skirts, dresses or leggings. Trousers should <u>NOT</u> be made of stretchy fabric.
- A shirt/blouse with collar. Sleeveless shirts/blouses are not allowed.
- Please note that jumpers may be worn under a suit jacket in colder months but **do not** replace a suit jacket.
- A pair of smart business-like leather shoes
- Security Pass on lanyard, visible always (provided at induction)
- Hair should be natural colours only.
- Minimal makeup and NO false eyelashes
- Small stud earrings only are allowed. Large hoops, eyebrow, nose and other face studs and rings are **not** allowed.

The following are strictly <u>forbidden:</u>

- Denim or leather jackets
- Tracksuit bottoms
- Sweatshirts
- Polo-neck jumpers
- Hooded tops or zip-up cardigans
- Trainers or canvas shoes
- Hats inside the building
- 'Peaked' caps of any kind
- 'Chequered' shirts
- Durags and bonnets
- No combs or other hair styling equipment to be worn in hair.

The following items ARE permitted

- Over-garments e.g. coat/hat/gloves etc. of your choice. Students should be aware that any garments that are deemed unsuitable by the sixth form team are liable for confiscation (for example clothing with inappropriate slogans or imagery)
- A bag of your choice

The following items are permitted, but are not to be used in areas of the school outside of the sixth form study areas (such as classrooms, corridors and communal areas)

- Mobile phone
- Personal MP3 player, if separate from above
- Headphones

On Non-uniform days, sixth formers are also expected to dress appropriately.

All other decisions regarding the suitability of students' appearance may be made at the discretion of the Sixth Form Team.
